Sir Philip was also the Church Warden for many years and, throughout his Patronage, was a constant source of advice and support when the church building and its fabric were in need of urgent action. There is so much for which to give thanks, and to celebrate in his devoted and devout contribution to the life of this village and Church and we all send our thoughts and prayers to Lady Rachel and her family.
