### **SUNDAY 4th March – The Second Sunday in Lent.**

Welcome to everyone at **11 o'clock** for our celebration of **Holy Communion** this morning, led by Father Colin Griffiths. This will be the second of the five Sunday services in Lent where the readings will be those used for the Lent Discussion Groups. The readings are taken from **Isaiah Chapter 40** and today the readings are:

**Isaiah 40 vs. 3 – 5**, the Lent discussion verses;  
**Hebrews 4 vs. 12 – 16**; and  
**Mark 1 vs. 9 – 15**.

**THE SECOND SESSION OF THE LENT COURSE**, preceded by a simple lunch, will be held this coming Thursday (8th March) at Roxburgh House, Ivy Lane.
