maintenance, etc. Most of the cost is covered by voluntary giving of church members and supporters, and from collections at services. Most of the rest (about £5000) is covered by fundraising events and in a good year, this is achievable. However this year, we had to cancel a major event, so we are a little behind, which is why we organised the barbecue at short notice!

We hold prayer meetings on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday each month and you're welcome to come along and join us, just to listen and pray if you don't feel comfortable to pray aloud.
