Whilst writing we have been asked to pass on news of an event in the village on Sunday, 11th November to commemorate 100 years since the armistice of World War 1:-

" The Parish Council would like to advise that there will be a **commemorative lighting of the village beacon, on the cricket field at 7pm on Sunday 11th November**. Our beacon will be lit in coordination with a national initiative to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the World War 1 armistice. Also at 7:05pm the church bells will be rung in celebration of the armistice.
