CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) OUTBREAK Update 28th November 2020

ADVENT SUNDAY:

The first Sunday of Advent is tomorrow. We would normally have the candle-lit Advent Carol Service at Bow Brickhill. As we are unable to hold this very popular service in the church there will be a virtual Advent Carol Service via Zoom at 5.00pm, which will be as similar as possible to the usual service.

Instead of wrapping up and taking a torch to Bow Brickhill, why not stay in the warm and have a candle ready to light during the service.

DECEMBER SERVICES:

Following the publication of the Government's Covid-19 Winter Plan on Monday, permission has been given for the resumption of public worship from the end of the second lock down period on 2nd December, regardless of the location and tier. We await the full guidance to know exactly what the restrictions will be.

A schedule of services has been planned – see the schedule below. All of the services are subject to change and every endeavour will be made to circulate details of any changes. Further information will be sent out regarding The Village Nativity.

It will not be possible to hold our normal Nine Lessons and Carols on Christmas Eve. We are however planning to do a virtual Nine Lessons and Carols with pre-recorded material filmed in the church. This is very much in the planning stage and details will be circulated when we are certain of what the regulations will allow us to do.

Next Sunday there will be a service of Holy Communion at Great Brickhill at 11am.

We expect that the restrictions from before the lock down will still be in force:

- There will be no congregational singing
- Hand sanitizing will be required on entry to the church
- Single-use service sheets will be used
- Seating will be in accordance with social distancing rules
- Masks are a mandatory requirement
- We will ask for contact details, which we have to keep for 21 days
