# NEW SERVICE PATTERN FOR THE BENEFICE:

Each parish will generally have a Holy Communion service at 9.30am and a Family Service at 11.00am. The services for the third and fourth weeks will be determined at local level. A fifth Sunday will give an opportunity to hold special different style/different venue services. In Great Brickhill, the pattern in a normal month will be:-

1st Sunday:- 9.30am Holy Communion

2nd Sunday:- Prayer Book Evensong / Mattins / Holy Communion

3rd Sunday:- 11.00am Family Service

4th Sunday:- No fixed service, occasional ad hoc service

There will be a monthly benefice service at one of the churches on a rotational basis at 10.00am, taking the place of the normal Holy Communion service at that church.

For the time being, for those who are not yet ready to attend church, the weekly reflections and stories will continue.
