BISHOP OF OXFORD'S APPOINTMENT PROCESS:

The announcement of Bishop Steven's pending retirement caused the Vacancy-in-See Committee to be convened. The Committee met last month with the Prime Minister's and Archbishops' Appointments Secretaries, again this week and five further meetings are scheduled, culminating in a meeting in March at which six representatives will be elected to join eight others to form the Crown Nominations Commission who will meet later this year to identify who should be recommended to the Crown to be the next Bishop of Oxford. **This is obviously a long process, but alongside this, the Diocese would like to hear from anyone living, working or worshipping in the diocese - the consultation period is now open via an online link below, until Wednesday 4th February at 5pm:-**
