SUNDAY 25th JULY 2021: EIGHTH SUNDAY AFTER TRINITY CELEBRATING THE FEAST OF St JAMES

Welcome to our service of Holy Communion, led by the Rector, the first service to be held after the easing of the Covid restrictions. The Church of England has issued guidance saying that, although they cannot enforce any restriction, each church can encourage certain restrictions to remain. The Rector in consultation with the Wardens at each church will decide what is appropriate for that church. The main criteria for any decision are made on the size of the building and the likely number in the congregation. It will therefore be different restrictions that will be recommended at each of our four churches. The main differences will be regarding congregational singing and the wearing of face coverings.

Please see below what is recommended for here in Great Brickhill:

- Ask people to socially distance, using every other pew
- The doors will be open for ventilation
- Communion will be administered in the same way as recently
- Hymn singing will take place but the congregation will be asked to remain seated
- Individuals to decide whether they wish to wear a mask or not
- The QR code will remain on the door for test and trace
- Contact details taken from those who wish to provide them
- The collection will be taken as in recent weeks

We are therefore looking forward today to being able to sing hymns. Also, the choir will be providing sung settings for part of the liturgy.

The readings for this morning are:-

Acts <u>11</u>: 27 – <u>12</u>: 2; 2 Corinthians <u>4</u>: 7-15; Matthew <u>20</u>: 20-28

The collection/envelopes should be placed in the plate on the table in the cross aisle before the start of the service.

Before the 19th July the go ahead had been received for refreshments to be served and so we are delighted to be able to use our new refreshment area to offer tea and coffee after the service.
